Accommodation

There are two 5-star, 14 4-star and 13 3-star Hotels in Verona. It is also possible to stay on nearby Lake Garda – e.g. in Peschiera di Garda or in Sirmione.

In view of the focus on attending opera performances, guests may prefer not to have to get on a coach for every performance – so staying in Verona may be preferable.

Travel from/to UK

There is a good choice of flights with scheduled carriers to Milan or Venice from a number of UK cities. In addition, BA have 2 daily flights from London Gatwick to Verona (2009 timetable).

Day One:

- travel from UK
- transfer to Hotel
- relax on Piazza delle Erbe

Day Two:

- stroll through Verona in the morning
 - o San Zeno (Mantegna triptych)
- Stay by the river for cooler air in the afternoon teatro Romano, palazzo della Ragione
- First opera performance in the Arena

Day Three:

- Palladian Villas:
 - o all day Boat trip along the Brenta canal from Padua to Venice
 - o moor at and visit 4 Palladian villas during this cruise (incl. the astonishing 'Malcontenta')

Day Four:

- morning: Castelvecchio museum in Verona
- afternoon: visit to vinyard, or free time
- Second opera performance in the Arena

Day Five:

- Day trip to Asolo, Bassano del Grappa, Castelfranco Veneto
 - Asolo: picturesque hill town, associations with Robert Browning,
 Eleonora Duse and Gabriele d'Annunzio
 - Bassano: piazza Montevecchio (frescoed houses), medieval covered bridge
 - Castelfranco Veneto: town still surrounded by full walls; home of Giorgione (altar piece in church)

Day Six:

return flight to UK
